Part 2 Commission Specific Conditions

Conditions specific to providing facilities for playing bingo

This licence is subject to the conditions that:

- (a) the licensee must also hold a non-remote bingo operating licence; and
- (b) this licence only authorises the provision of facilities for the playing of bingo:
 - (i) by means of remote communication equipment; and
 - (ii) by people who are situated on the premises in respect of which a bingo premises licence has effect.

Conditions specific to providing facilities for betting other than pool betting

This licence is subject to the conditions that:

- (a) the licensee must also hold a non-remote general betting (standard) operating licence; and
- (b) this licence only authorises the provision of facilities for betting
 - (i) by means of a machine, other than a gaming machine, used for the purpose of making or accepting bets on premises in respect of which a betting premises licence has effect, or
 - (ii) in circumstances in which each bet made or accepted pursuant to this licence occurs only by means of a telephone or by email, and is provided, operated or administered by an individual, and
- (c) with regards the provision of facilities for betting in circumstances in which each bet made or accepted pursuant to this licence occurs only by means of a telephone or by email, the licensee may only generate an annual gross gambling yield
 - (i) which is less than the annual gross gambling yield generated by activities authorised by the non-remote operating licence, and
 - (ii) does not in any event exceed £550,000.
